

AGREEMENT

Miami Anatomical Research Center – M.A.R.C. Institute

Applied Surgical Anatomy Program

Dates: July 13, 14 and 15, 2026

1. Parties

This Agreement is entered into between:

- Provider: Miami Anatomical Research Center, hereinafter referred to as “MARC Institute.”
- Participant: The individual signing this Agreement, hereinafter referred to as “Participant.”

2. Program Description

The Program will take place on July 13-15, 2026, at the MARC Institute in Miami, and consists of applied surgical anatomy sessions, including lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on training with anatomical specimens. The Program is designed exclusively for medical students.

3. Eligibility

By signing this Agreement, the Participant confirms that they are currently enrolled in a medical school (college or university) and commits to submitting proof of enrollment. MARC Institute reserves the right to cancel participation without refund if proof is not provided.

4. Fees and Payment

Program fees must be paid in full prior to the start of the Program. Details regarding payment methods and deadlines will be provided separately.

5. Refund Policy

- Cancellations made at least 30 days prior to the start of the Program are eligible for a 50% refund.
- Cancellations made less than 30 days of the Program start date are non-refundable.

- Refunds, if applicable, will be processed within 60 days of written cancellation notice minus credit card fees and \$150 for handling fees.
- If the course needs to be cancelled due to force majeure events the student will receive the money back minus credit card handling fees.

6. Participant Responsibilities

- All travel accommodation, meals, transportation and personal expenses are the responsibility of the Participant.
- Participants are encouraged to maintain valid health and accident insurance for the duration of the Program.
- Participants must comply with all facility rules and safety protocols. Failure to comply may result in dismissal from the Program without refund.
- Participants are required to provide proof of enrollment in a medical school (college or university) after signing this Agreement.
- Participants are solely responsible for obtaining and maintaining all necessary visas, passports, and travel documents required for entry into the United States. The MARC Institute does not provide visa application assistance.
- Participants understand that pictures during hands-on sessions are not allowed, and not complying will result in no longer able to participate in the course.
- Participants understand that the M.A.R.C. Institute will provide a certificate of attendance only, which is not an accreditation.
- Participants must follow all lab safety rules, wear PPE, and comply with OSHA and biosafety protocols.
- MARC's employees have the right to remove any participant who poses a safety or compliance risk.
- No Removal of Materials: removal, transportation, or personal possession of biological material is prohibited and constitutes grounds for immediate expulsion and legal action.

7. Certificates

Participants who attend the full Program and comply with all Program requirements will receive a Certificate of Attendance issued by the MARC Institute.

This certificate recognizes participation in the Medical Students Program and does not confer academic credit.

8. Data Protection

MARC Institute will collect and process Participant's personal data solely for the purposes of administering the Program and will not share such data with third parties except as required by law.

9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, USA.

10. Arbitration Clause

Any dispute, claim, or controversy arising out of or relating to this Agreement, the Participant's participation in the course, or the interpretation, breach, termination, or validity of this Agreement shall be resolved exclusively and finally by binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association (AAA) in accordance with its Commercial Arbitration Rules. The arbitration shall take place in Miami-Dade County, Florida, before a single arbitrator. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon both parties and may be entered as a judgment in any court of competent jurisdiction. Each party shall bear its own costs and attorney's fees, except as otherwise determined by the arbitrator.

By signing this Agreement, the Participant affirms that they have read and fully understand the terms of the arbitration provision and agree to be bound by them.

11. Intellectual Property

By signing below, the Participant acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to the terms of this Agreement; and that all course materials, images, or derived data belong to the Miami Anatomical Research Center.

12. Liability Waiver and Assumption of Risk

The Participant acknowledges and understands that the course involves direct exposure to and handling of human anatomical specimens for educational and training purposes. The Participant hereby confirms that they are voluntarily participating in the course with full knowledge of the nature of the activities involved.

The Participant agrees to assume all risks associated with participation, including but not limited to physical, emotional, or psychological discomfort that may arise from exposure to human

anatomical specimens. The Participant expressly waives and releases the MARC Institute, its officers, directors, employees, representatives, and affiliates from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, damages, or causes of action of any kind, whether known or unknown, that may result from participation in the course, except in cases of proven gross negligence or willful misconduct by the MARC Institute.
